

Starting with the active player and moving clockwise, each player with an Assistant here *names* a different category.

Reveal 4 book cards from the deck. The player whose named category has the most matching books amongst the revealed book cards *wins* and *takes* all the revealed book cards that match their category.

Discard all the remaining book cards. The winner may **shelve** one of the book cards they took for every player with Assistants at this location.

8 LIBRARIANS LODGE

You may *perform* the following actions once each, in whatever order you choose:

- A. *Move* one of your other Assistants from a location's Assistant space to one of your home library spaces and *perform* a home action.
- B. **Swap** I card from your bookshelf with I card in your hand -or- **swap** I card from your bookshelf with another card from your bookshelf -or-remove I card from your bookshelf, then **shelve** it again in any legal position.

9 BOOK COLLECTOR



Discard any number of book cards. Count the number of category icons on the discarded book cards that match a category icon on the book card in this location's card area.

Draw book cards equal to half that number, rounded down. You may **shelve** up to two of the book cards drawn.

BOOK SELLER



Take I book card from this location's card area. You may shelve it.

GARBAGE DUMP

Name a category, then **search** the discard pile. **Take** any one book card containing a book of the named category.

If no book cards are present in the discard pile that contain a book of the named category, you receive nothing.

If you took a book card, you may shelve it.

LOCAL DRAPTHOUSE

The player with an Assistant on the first space of this location *reveals* two book cards from the deck for every Assistant present.

Players with Assistants present at this location then take turns *drafting* one of the revealed book cards for each of their Assistants, in the order they appear on the spaces, until all the revealed book cards have been taken.

Afterward, any/all of the taken book cards may be **shelved**.
